- 4. "The tragedy of Oedipus lies in his knowledge of the guilt rather than the guilt itself". Do you agree? Give reasons for your answer.
- 5. Explore 'guilt and sin' as major theme in Aeschylus's *Agamemnon*.
- 6. Critically examine the character of Creon in *Oedipus the King*.

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
